- Talk to someone they trust whether that their parent, coach or the Head of Safeguarding if they're unhappy with anything at the Lets Kick It. (If we don't know, we cant make it better).

As a member of Lets Kick It, you have the right to:

- Be safe and happy at football
- Be able to speak to your coaches or the Head of Safeguarding if you have any problems at football, home or school.
- Have support from your coaches in your journey to improve and enjoy your football.
- Tell your coaches any ideas and thoughts you have on how we can make your experience at Lets Kick It even better! We will listen as we are here for you!

Any minor misdemeanours and general misbehaviour will be dealt with immediately and reported verbally to the designated person. Serious or persistent breach of the code will result in you being asked not to attend training/matches and could lead to dismissal from the Club. Parents will be informed at all stages. There is no appeal procedure to a dismissal.
